



## THE STRANGE WORLD OF QUANTUM RECHANICS

The word "Quantum" means "a small amount". In Physics, it means the smallest packet of something. For example- if you go to a store, you can buy 1 candy, 2 candies, 3 candies and so on. But if you tell the shopkeeper "Uncle! Please give me 1.3 candies and 2.7 eggs", he will think you have gone crazy. So here 1 candy or 1 egg is the smallest packet or "quantum", you can't get parts or fractions of it.

What is quantum mechanics? It's a theory which describes the behaviour of light and sub-atomic particles.

The scientist Max Planck is called the father of Quantum Physics, who explained the famous problem of Blackbody Radiation. He considered light energy in the form of "small packets of energy" called Photons. Albert Einstein received the 1921 Nobel Prize in Physics mainly due to his explanation of Photo-electric effect using Photons. Later Quantum theory was developed by Schrodinger, Heisenberg and Paul Dirac. But day by day Quantum Theory became so weird that Einstein attacked it.



### Mr. Cat are you dead or alive? Both.

#### What?

In this thought experiment, known as Schrodinger's Cat a cat is put in a box. The box has a container of poison which can be broken by a hammer. The hammer is operated by a radioactive source. When the box is not open, we can't say whether the cat is dead or alive. Quantum theory says it is in superposition of two states I dead > and I alive > . When an observer opens the box, the state of the cat collapses into one of the states. In Quantum theory when a paricle is not observed it spreads out as a wave, but when you observe it, it collapses into one definite state.


There is one controversial interpretation called MANY WORLDS INTERPRETATION. According to this interpretation, the cat exists in two different worlds or branches of a multiverse which are equally real. In one of the worlds it alive and in the other it is dead!



#### Its all Probabilities!

If you ask the question "Where is the particle?", Quantum theory does not give you a single answer. Rather it gives you a function - the *Wave function*. From this wave function you can get the probability of finding a particle at a place. That's it and no more.


For example, in Rutherford's model or Bohr's model of the atom, you could say the electron is this much distance away from the nucleus. In quantum mechanics we say the electron is in this orbital, which is not a point but a region in space. So where is the electron? Quantum theory can give you probabilities. This is shown by electron cloud. The probability to find the electron is more, where this cloud is denser.



#### Its Spooky!

If two particles interact, they may get entangled. Now let these particles be separated by millions of kilometres. If you perform a measurement on the first particle, you also know the state of the second particle. No information can travel faster than light. So how the second particle knows that a measurement has been done on the first particle? Einstein called this "spooky action at a distance". This entanglement is one of the basic features of Quantum Mechanics. The 2022 Nobel prize was awarded to Alain Aspect, John Clauser and Anton Zelinger for their contribution in the field of Quantum entanglement.

In classical physics we can confidently say the particle is at x = 3 m and has momentum p= 5 kg m/s. But in Quantum theory the position and momentum of a particle cannot be measured simultaneously with 100% accuracy. If you try to measure position more accurately, the momentum measurement becomes erroneous and vice-versa. This fact looks on the face of it—Absurd! But countless experiments have confirmed it.


### 8. No more hardships in conducting elections or
