

EDUCATIONAL TRIP

A day-long educational trip to Science City, Kolkata was organized on January II, 2023 for classes VII - XII. The stimulants of the truly magical Science City ranging from a sprawling amusement park to aquarium, maritime centre and several exhibits, kept a group of 130 students engaged for several hours. The contemporary and imaginative exhibits, working models, virtual world, activity corners, laboratories and live demonstrations provided an understanding of science and technology to the students. They were awestruck to view the Human Panorama Show and Evolution Park which features large walkways, 71 robotic pre-historic animals, 26 dinosaurs, 140 early plant models and 3-D effects theatre with a special Polaroid spectacle.
